

## **UK COACHING CERTIFICATE LEVELS 1 AND 2**

UKCC (UK Coaching Certificate) courses will be held throughout 2009. It is expected that all those wishing to coach polocrosse will become UKCC coaches. Any previous courses and experience will be taken into consideration. To be considered for the courses each candidate should complete an APL (accredited prior learning) questionnaire and supply evidence of experience/qualification. The pre requisites for Levels 1 and 2 are listed below.

An APL form will then be forwarded to you for completion.

### **Pre Requisites for Level 1 (Assistant Coach)**

Candidates must be aged 16 or above on the day of the final assessment.  
Basic one day first aid certificate  
Safeguarding children certificate  
CRB (Criminal Records Bureau) disclosure  
Proof of technical competence (either by certification or sign off by a coach educator)

### **Pre Requisites for Level 2 (Coach)**

Candidates must be aged 18 or above on the day of the final assessment  
Four day "At Work" First Aid course or two day ESFAC course  
Safeguarding Children certificate  
CRB (Criminal Records Bureau) disclosure  
Proof of technical competence must be by certificate or for existing coaches by Accredited Prior Learning

Note:

It is proposed that all candidates will do the 2 day ESFAC first aid course if they do not already hold a valid first aid certificate

CRB checks will be done through the Pony Club and held by the PC office

Safeguarding children course will be run by the UKPA
